HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2293, L.D. 2344, Bill, "AN ACT
to Clarify the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 18 by inserting in the first sentence
after the amending clause after the words "and shall" the
following underlined word 'not'

Further amend said Bill in section 39 by striking out all of
paragraph B of subsection 2 and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'B. If an absentee ballot for such applicant which was
furnished to a designated 3rd person is not returned
to the clerk's office within 5 business days of the date
such ballot was sent or delivered to such 3rd person or by
10 a.m. on the day before election day, whichever is earlier.
This paragraph shall not be construed to affect the time
for delivery of absentee ballots under section 1255.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to correct errors in the bill
and to clarify the wording of the bill.
