HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 2293, L.D. 2344, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 56 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 56. 21 MRSA §1577, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1973,
c. 199, §2, is repealed and the following enacted in place
thereof:

1. Exceptions. Ballots, absentee ballot applications,
absentee ballot envelopes, nomination petitions and primary
petitions are not public records and may be inspected only in
accordance with this Title.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment adds nomination petitions and primary
petitions to the types of election documents that are not public
records and that may be inspected only in accordance with
procedures under the election laws.
