HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H.P. 2293, L.D. 2344, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill in section 2, by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:
'The voting at meetings held in towns shall be held and conducted in accordance with Title 30, sections 2061 to 2065, even though the town has not accepted the provisions of sections 2061 and 2062, provided that the facsimile signature of the clerk referred to in section 2061, subsection 5, paragraph F shall be that of the chairman of the board of directors and provided that if a district meeting is called to be ld simultaneously with a general election or primary election the voting in towns shall be held and conducted in accordance with Title 21, except that the duties of the Secretary of State shall be performed by the district directors.

Statement of Fact

This Amendment combines the change to Title 20, section 225, subsection 2, paragraph G, first sentence which was proposed by L.D.2056, that which was proposed by section 2 of the Education Errors Bill, and this Bill, in order to avoid a conflict between 2 differing changes proposed by the 2 bills.
