SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 2293, L.D. 2344, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Election Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 40 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 40. 21 MRSA \$1253, sub-\$3, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 387, §3, is amended by adding at the end the following sentences:

The clerk shall submit such list to the registrar for certification before the close of business on the day prior to election day. Such lists shall not become public records until the day of the election for which the lists are prepared.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the lists of absentee voters in a municipality shall not become a public record until election day.
