HOUSE AMENDMENT/to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 97 the following:

'Sec. 97-A. 26 MRSA §1028, sub-§2, first sentence,  
as last amended by PL 1975, c.671, §21 and by c. 697, §15, is  
repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:  
Any person aggrieved by any ruling or determination of the  
executive director under sections 1024 and 1025 may appeal, within  
15 days of the announcement of the ruling or determination, except  
that in the instance of objections to the conduct of an election  
or challenged ballots the time period shall be 5 working days,  
to the Maine Labor Relations Board.

Sec. 97-B. Effective date. Section 97-A of this Act  
shall become effective October 2, 1976.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections to read  
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to resolve a conflict in  
the public laws passed by the first special session of the 107th  
Legislature, chapters 671 and 697.
