HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1474." of section 51 by adding a new paragraph to subsection 1 to read as follows:

'If any vehicle equipment is found to be defective at the time of sale as to the motor vehicle inspection requirements, the motor vehicle shall be returned to the dealer by the purchaser within 5 working days after the date of sale and the vehicle equipment shall be repaired by the dealer.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the purchaser shall return the motor vehicle to the dealer within 5 working days of the sale if the motor vehicle is found to have been defective as to the motor vehicle inspection requirements and the dealer shall repair such equipment.
