HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to S. P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 107 the following:

'Sec. 107-A. 29 MRSA §1, sub-§1-B, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 731, §19, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

1-B. Authorized emergency vehicle. "Authorized emergency vehicle" shall mean:

A. Vehicles of the fire department;

B. Police vehicles;

C. Municipal ambulances, emergency vehicles and volunteer fire department vehicles, including vehicles privately-owned by members of such volunteer fire departments; and

D. Emergency vehicles of public service corporations as are designated or authorized by the Commissioner of Transportation.

Sec. 107-B. Effective date. Section 107-A of this Act shall become effective May 2, 1976.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the subsection dealing with authorized emergency vehicles.
