HOUSE AMENDMENT "I" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN
ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 107 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 107. 28 MRSA §153, first sentence, as last amended
by PL 1975, c. 741, §8, is repealed and the following enacted
in place thereof:

The State Liquor Commission shall have authority to license and
regulate, in cities, towns and unorganized territories which
have voted in favor of the operation of state stores under local
option provisions and where there are no state stores, and on islands
which are within cities, towns and unorganized territories where
there are state stores but which are not connected to those
cities, towns and unorganized territories by bridge and which
have no state stores on them, retailers as special agency stores
on an annual, seasonal or temporary basis for the purposes of
selling liquor in sealed bottles, containers or original packages
for consumption off the premises.

Sec. 107-A. Effective date. Section 107 of this Act shall
become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections to read consecutive
Statement of Fact

This amendment makes the language of section 153 of Title
28 consistent with chapter 741 of the public laws of 1975.
