HOUSE AMENDMENT "J" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN
ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 175 the
following:

'Sec. 176. Resolves, 1975, c. 43, is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment repeals the resolve passed earlier this
session which authorized and directed the Director of the
Bureau of Public Lands to issue a stumpage permit to Great
Northern Paper Company. It has now been indicated by tax
counsel for the company that such resolve may not be in
compliance with the Internal Revenue Code.
