HOUSE AMENDMENT "K " to S. P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill,
"AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 111 the
following:

'Sec. 111-A. 29 MRSA §1368, sub-§1, last sentence,
as last repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 653, is amended
to read:

Nothing herein shall limit the use of lights showing a red
beam of light to the front or rear of school buses, provided
those lights are of a type approved by the Commissioner of
Educational and Cultural Services as stated in section 2012;
nor shall any designation or authorization by the Commissioner
of Transportation be required for the use of emergency lights
authorized under this section.

Sec. 111-B. Effective date. Section 111-A of this Act
shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the
Legislature.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.
