HOUSE AMENDMENT " O " to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 104 the following section:

'Sec. 104-A. 28 MRSA §52, first sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 741, §4, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The State Liquor Commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members to be appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, to serve for 3 years and may be removed by the Governor on the address of both branches of the Legislature or by impeachment.

Sec. 104-B. Effective date. Section 104-A of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature and shall continue in effect until January 3, 1977.

Sec. 104-C. 28 MRSA §52, first sentence is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The State Liquor Commission, as heretofore established, shall consist of 3 members to be appointed by the Governor, subject to review by the Joint Standing Committee on Liquor Control and to confirmation by the Legislature, to serve for 3 years and may be removed by the Governor on the address of both branches of the Legislature or by impeachment.

Sec. 104-D. Effective date. Section 104-C of this Act shall become effective January 4, 1977.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections of the bill to read consecutively.
