SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of sections 121 to 128.

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The results of previous studies conducted by the Joint Standing Committee on Public Utilities have determined that there should not be government control/operation of private cable television. This amendment deletes portions from the bill which would permit that operation.
