

## STATE OF MAINE SENATE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION 107TH LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "G " to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 144 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 144. 32 MRSA §4854, 1st sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 477, §4, is amended to read: There is established in the Department of Agriculture a State Board of Veterinary Medicine, which shall consist of 5 <u>6</u> members, appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture, all <u>5</u> of whom shall be licensed Maine veterinarians who are residents of this State, graduates of a veterinary school and who have been licensed to practice veterinary medicine in Maine for the 5 years preceding their appointment <u>and one member who</u> shall be a representative of the public.

Sec. 144-A. 32 MRSA §4854, as enacted by FL 1975, c. 477, §4, is amended by adding after the 5th sentence a new sentence to read:

The public member to be appointed to the board shall serve a 5-year term.'
