SENATE AMENDMENT "G" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill,
"AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 144 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 144. 32 MRSA §4854, 1st sentence, as enacted by
PL 1975, c. 477, §4, is amended to read:

There is established in the Department of Agriculture a State
Board of Veterinary Medicine, which shall consist of 5 6
members, appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture, ~~at~~ 5
of whom shall be licensed Maine veterinarians who are residents
of this State, graduates of a veterinary school and who have
been licensed to practice veterinary medicine in Maine for
the 5 years preceding their appointment and one member who
shall be a representative of the public.

Sec. 144-A. 32 MRSA §4854, as enacted by PL 1975,
c. 477, §4, is amended by adding after the 5th sentence a
new sentence to read:

The public member to be appointed to the board shall serve a
5-year term.'
