SENATE AMENDMENT "H " to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 75 the following:

'Sec. 75-A. 21 MRSA §441, sub-§2, as last amended by

PL 1973, c. 414, §15, is further amended by inserting at the end
the following:

A person may not file, whether by primary election or nomination petition, as a candidate for more than one federal, state or county office at any election.

Sec. 75-B. 21 MRSA §491, sub-§2, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 414, §20, is further amended by inserting at the end the following:

A person may not file, whether by primary election or nomination petition, as a candidate for more than one federal, state or county office at any election.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections to read consecutive Statement of Fact

This amendment makes clear what is implied in the law now, that a person may file for only one federal, state or county office at any election.
