SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 75 the following:

'Sec. 75-A. 21 MRSA §441, sub-§2, as last amended by  
PL 1973, c. 414, §15, is further amended by inserting at the end  
the following:

A person may not file, whether by primary election or nomination  
petition, as a candidate for more than one federal, state or  
county office at any election.

Sec. 75-B. 21 MRSA §491, sub-§2, as last amended by PL  
1973, c. 414, §20, is further amended by inserting at the end  
the following:

A person may not file, whether by primary election or nomination  
petition, as a candidate for more than one federal, state or county  
office at any election.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections to read consecutive
