SENATE AMENDMENT "K" to S.P. 799, L.D. 2345, Bill, "AN ACT
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in Laws of Maine."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 104 the following
section:

'Sec. 104-A. 28 MRSA §4, 6th ¶, as last repealed and replaced
by PL 1975, c. 741, §2, is amended by inserting at the end the
following new sentence:

Except that wholesalers of malt beverages and table wine may
make deliveries to licensees on the day of holding a general
election or state-wide primary.

Sec. 104-B. Effective date. Section 104-A of this Act
shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections to read
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows wholesalers of malt beverages and
wine to make deliveries on election day which is now current
law, inadvertently repealed in L. D. 2311.
