HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 2310, L.D. 2348, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Suppression of the Spruce Budworm Epidemic."

Amend said Bill in section 3 by striking out in subsection 2 of that part designated "§1022." all of the next to the last sentence and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Each member shall be entitled to his actual expenses, to be drawn from the Budworm Suppression Fund.'

This amendment deletes from the bill the authority to pay per diem to members of the Committee on Spruce Fir Silviculture.
