AN ACT to Provide Necessary Corrections in the Education Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 20 MRSA § 225, sub-§ 2, ¶ G, first sentence, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 746, § 5-A, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 2014, sub-§ 1, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 746, § 25-A, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

1. Seating. No vehicle shall be operated as a school bus unless a minimum of 13 inches of seating space is provided for each child and there shall be no auxiliary seating accommodations such as temporary or folding jump seats. Effective September 1, 1977, seating shall be provided that will permit each occupant to sit in a plain view lateral location.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate a conflict in Title 20, section 225, subsection 2, paragraph G. This bill also repeals a change contained in Public Law 1975, chapter 746.
