Amend said Amendment in section 9 by striking out all of the
next to the last sentence.

Statement of Fact

This Amendment deletes from the provisions governing merit
increases the sentence which permits the Governor to include in
the next budget only sufficient funds for 60% of those eligible
for merit increases.
