HOUSE AMENDMENT "P" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 813, L.D. 2355, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Reallocate Appropriations from the General Fund for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1976 and June 30, 1977 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government."

Amend said Amendment in "PART A" by striking out the last paragraph under "Aid to Families with Dependent Children" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Commencing October 1, 1976, all amounts of money not to exceed \$1,000,000 saved from February 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977 within the AFDC Program from any source shall be used to increase grant payments.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies legislative intent by insuring that beginning October 1, 1976, all moneys up to \$1,000,000 saved from February 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977 in the AFDC Program shall be used to increase AFDC grant payments.
