Sec. 2. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§5, 5th and 11th lines from the end are repealed as follows:

Employment-Security-Commission-members,-other-than-the-Chairman;
Chairman-of-the-Industrial-Accident-Commission;

Sec. 3. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§6, 4th and 5th lines from the end are repealed as follows:

Public-Utilities-Commission-members,-other-than-the-Chairman;
Industrial-Accident-Commission-members,-other-than-the-Chairman;

Further amend said Amendment in "Part C" by renumbering sections 1 to 22 to be sections 5 to 26.

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes the salaries of the chairmen and members of the Public Utilities Commission and the Industrial Commission

Accident/and members of the Employment Security Commission and provides for a 5% increase in their present salaries.

The amendment repeals and replaces Title 2, section 7 in its entirety for clarity only; the present statutory salaries of the constitutional officers remain as they are at present in the statutes.
