HOUSE AMENDMENT " R " to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 813,  
L.D. 2355, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Reallocate Appropriations  
from the General Fund for the Expenditures of State Government  
for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1976 and June 30, 1977 and  
Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper  
Operations of State Government."

Amend said Amendment by inserting after the caption "PART C"  
the following:

'Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§4, 5th line from the end is repealed  
as follows:

~~Chairman-of-the-Public-Utilities-Commission;~~

Sec. 2. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§5, 5th and 11th lines from the end  
are repealed as follows:

~~Employment-Security-Commission-members,-other-than-the-Chairman;~~

~~Chairman-of-the-Industrial-Accident-Commission;~~

Sec. 3. 2 MRSA §6, sub-§6, 4th and 5th lines from the end  
are repealed as follows:

~~Public-Utilities-Commission-members,-other-than-the-Chairman;~~

~~Industrial-Accident-Commission-members,-other-than-the-Chairman;~~

Sec. 4. 2 MRSA §7, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c.780 §2-A, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

§7. Constitutional officers and regulatory boards

1. Constitutional officers. Notwithstanding section 6 or any other provision of law, the respective salaries of the Attorney General, Secretary of State, State Auditor and Treasurer of State shall be as follows:

<u>Attorney General.....</u>	<u>\$25,500;</u>
<u>Secretary of State.....</u>	<u>20,000;</u>
<u>State Auditor.....</u>	<u>17,500;</u>
<u>Treasurer of State.....</u>	<u>15,000;</u>

2. Regulatory boards. Notwithstanding section 6 or any other provision of law, the salaries of the listed chairmen and of members of the following regulatory boards shall be:

Employment Security Commission

Members other than Chairman.....\$20,475;

Industrial Accident Commission

Chairman..... 20,475;

Members other than Chairman..... 18,900;

Public Utilities Commission

Chairman..... 22,050;

Members other than Chairman..... 18,900;

Further amend said Amendment in "Part C" by renumbering sections 1 to 22 to be sections 5 to 26.

Statement of Fact

This amendment establishes the salaries of the chairmen and members of the Public Utilities Commission and the Industrial Commission Accident/and members of the Employment Security Commission and provides for a 5% increase in their present salaries.

The amendment repeals and replaces Title 2, section 7 in its entirety for clarity only; the present statutory salaries of the constitutional officers remain as they are at present in the statutes.
