SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 813, L. D. 2355, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Reallocate Appropriations from the General Fund for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1976 and June 30, 1977 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government."

Amend said Amendment in "Part D" by striking out in section 6 everything after the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Temporary Compensation Review Board shall make every attempt to complete the review of and provide decisions on all appeals prior to the first day of November 1976. In the event that any appeals may remain undecided on November 1, 1976 the board shall complete those appeals as expeditiously as possible. Any appeals decided after November 1, 1976 shall include payments to the affected employees retroactive to the first pay period in November 1976.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to revise certain provisions relating to appeal under this Act.
