HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 821, L.D. 2361, Bill, "AN ACT to Revise and Reallocate Appropriations from the General Fund for the Expenditures of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1976 and June 30, 1977 and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government."

Amend said Bill in "PART A" under the caption "Human Services" under the heading "Medical Care" by striking out all of the last line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other 500,000'

Further amend said Bill in "PART A" under the caption "Human Services" under the heading "Intermediate Care" by striking out of the last line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other 1,084,500'

Further amend said Bill in "PART A" under the caption "Human Services" by striking out everything under the heading "Aid to Families with Dependent Children" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other

(4,188,400)

All Other

1,000,000

\$1,000,000 shall be used as of October 1, 1976, to increase AFDC payments for all eligible recipients as of that date.'

Further amend said Bill in "PART A" under the caption "Human Services" under the heading "General Assistance" by striking out all of the last line and inserting in place thereof the following:

'All Other

1,054,000'
