the following:

'Amend the Bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out in the first  
line the word "Amend" and inserting in its place the words  
'Further amend'

Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last  
paragraph before the Statement of Fact.

provisions from the original bill.
