HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 9, L.D. 19, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Removal of County Buildings."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, public assistance funds will be available for
purposes of this legislation upon application; and

Whereas, the county must be vested with control in order
to apply for these funds; and

Whereas, time is of the essence in order to make applicatio
to carry out the intended purposes; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution
of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end,
before the statement of fact, the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to put an emergency preamble and an emergency clause on the original bill.
