STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Provide that the First 5 Days of Deer Season Shall be for Maine Residents Only.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2353, 1st paragraph, as repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 208, § 1, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The first 5 days of each open season on deer shall be an open season only for residents of this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that during the first 5 days of each open season on deer only Maine residents may lawfully hunt deer.
