STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning Days on which Alcoholic Beverages may be Sold.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 28 MRSA § 4, 4th ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 741, § 2, is repealed as follows:

~~Liquor may be sold in any municipality on the day of holding a general election or statewide primary after the polls of that municipality have closed~~

Sec. 2. 28 MRSA § 4, 6th ¶, 2nd sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 770, § 131, is repealed as follows:

~~Except that wholesalers of malt beverages and table wine may make deliveries to licensees on the day of holding a general election or statewide primary~~

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the sale of alcoholic beverages on election day.
