COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 26, L. D. 35, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Sawdust and Shavings being Transported on Public Ways."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

'29 MRSA, §1752 is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

Any vehicle carrying sawdust or shavings shall have the load covered and the operator of the vehicle shall make reasonable efforts to contain the sawdust or shavings.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that any vehicle carrying sawdust or shavings shall have its load covered and the vehicle's driver shall make reasonable efforts to contain the sawdust or shavings.
