## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Sawdust and Shavings being Transported on Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 1752, 2nd ¶, last sentence is amended to read:

The word "load" as used in this paragraph shall include, but shall not be limited to, firewood, pulpwood, logs, bolts or other material, but shall not include loose hay, pea vines, straw, grain or, cornstalks, sawdust or shavings.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to exclude sawdust and shavings from the definition of "load" which will permit some spillage of biodegradable substances while being transported on ways and bridges.
