COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 27, L.D. 40, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide for Local Hearings by the Public Employees
Labor Relations Board."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the Title and inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT to Provide for Local Hearings by the Maine Labor Relations Board.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §968, sub-§6, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 609, §9, is amended by adding after the 2nd sentence the following:

The hearings shall be held in the county where the public employer has its headquarters, if both parties to the hearing so request.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Maine Labor Relations Board the sum of \$25,700 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
