AN ACT to Increase the Monetary Limitation on Flight Insurance Policies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

24-A MRSA § 2721-B, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 121 is amended to read:

§ 2721-B. Flight insurance limitation

Any insurance coverage over ~~\$60,000~~ **\$75,000** under a policy or policies of insurance issued by an insurer or insurers which covers or cover the life of any person for the duration of one specific journey via aircraft shall be void.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the flight insurance limits from \$60,000 to \$75,000 which would allow the sale of an additional multiple of \$25,000 on coin vending machines in airports.
