COMMITTEE AMENDMENT 'B' to H.P. 34, L.D. 51, Bill, "AN ACT
Concerning Bear Hunting with Dogs."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§2355-D." by
inserting at the end of the first underlined paragraph the
following new sentence:

'No such hunting party shall exceed 6 persons, excluding a
registered Maine guide.'

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "2355-D."
by striking out all of the 2nd underlined paragraph and in-
serting in its place the following:

'Any nonresident hunting bear with dogs shall be accompanied
by a registered Maine guide.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment limits the size of a hunting party, using
dogs to hunt bear, 6 persons, excluding the guide. This
amendment also specifies that all nonresidents using dogs to
hunt bear shall be accompanied by a registered Maine guide.
