AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the Cumberland County Register of Probate to \$10,500.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2, 4th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is further amended to read:

Cumberland County: County commissioners, \$5,787; clerk of courts, \$10,634; deputy clerk of courts, \$9,969; county treasurer, \$9,969; sheriff, \$11,710; register of deeds, \$9,969; deputy register of deeds, \$7,975; judge of probate, \$12,020; register of probate, ~~\$9,820~~ \$10,500;

Sec. 2. Retroactivity. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, this Act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature and shall be retroactive to January 1, 1977.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the salary of the Cumberland County register of probate from \$9,820 to \$10,500. The last increase to this register's salary was in July, 1974, and the rise in the cost of living since that time makes this increase necessary.
