AN ACT Concerning the Appointment of Deputy Registers of Probate.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

18 MRSA § 256, 1st sentence is amended to read:

Any register of probate in this State may, if he so desires, appoint any person ~~who is employed on a full-time basis in said probate office~~ as the deputy register of probate for said county and said deputy may perform any of the duties prescribed by law to be performed by the register of probate. **A deputy register of probate not appointed from among the full-time employees of a probate office shall be paid a salary equal to that of the register of probate appointing him.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill removes the requirement that a deputy register of probate must be appointed from among the full-time employees of the probate office, and sets the salary of a deputy register of probate not appointed from among the full-time employees of a probate office equal to that of the probate register appointing him.
