Amend the Bill by striking out in the 17th and 18th lines

(14th and 15th lines in L.D.) the underlined words

"provided that, business tenants of the authority shall be liable

for the taxes on income to the State of Maine"

The purpose of this amendment is to strike from the bill a condition both unnecessary to its purpose and one already in force in Title 36, Part 8, income taxes.
