Amend the Amendment in section 1 in the 11th line of  
paragraph C by inserting after the underlined words and  
punctuation "complexity of the intersection." the following  
underlined sentence: 'A hearing shall be held, in any community  
where there are 10 or more signals, to assist in determining  
whether or not a right turn on red may be prohibited.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require a hearing, in  
certain communities, so that the public may assist in determining  
whether or not a right turn on red may be prohibited.
