HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 43,
L.D. 60, Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Vehicular Traffic to Turn Right
at a Red Light."

Amend the amendment in section 1 by inserting at the end
the following new sentence:

'To facilitate the implementation of this paragraph the
municipal officers of any municipality having more than 10
traffic signals shall hold a public hearing.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide an opportunity
in the larger communities for the public to participate in the
determination as to whether or not to prohibit a right turn on a
red light.
