HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 38, L.D. 64, Bill, "AN ACT
to Authorize Use of Emergency Lights and Signals by State Liquor
Inspectors."

Amend the Bill in the Title by inserting at the end, before
the period, the following:

'and on the Bureau of Forestry Vehicles used for Fire Fighting'

Further amend the Bill by inserting after the words
"Marine Resources" in the 15th line of section 1 (14th line
in L.D.) the underlined punctuation and words' Bureau of Forestry
vehicles used for fire fighting purposes'
