HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 52,
L.D. 73, Bill, "AN ACT Pertaining to Birth Records."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the underlined word
and punctuation "father." in the 8th line the following underlined
sentence:

'The signature of the mother and putative father on the written
consent shall be acknowledged before an official authorized to
take oaths.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires notarized signatures to the consent
form required of the mother and putative father of an illegitimate
child, if the birth certificate includes the name of the father.
