STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Clarify the Definition of Activities Reportable as Lobbying.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 3 MRSA § 317, sub-§ 1, ¶ A, as reenacted by PL 1975, c. 724, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
 - A. Compensation received or due to be received for lobbying or any activities directly connected with lobbying, including research, drafting, consultation or other preparation not otherwise reported during the previous month. In the case of a regular employee, such amount shall be the number of hours of activities as a lobbyist multiplied by the employee's regular rate of pay;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to clarify the definition of activities properly reportable as lobbying.
