AN ACT Pertaining to Town Clerk's Fees for Record of Burial Permits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2352, sub-§ 3, ¶ B is amended to read:

B. Burial permit, ~~50¢~~ \$2.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to change the fee from 50¢ to \$2.00. The present fee of 50¢ to issue and maintain a record of burial permits is not realistic. The 50¢ fee was established in 1957.
