STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT"A"to H.P. 58, L.D. 79, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Reapportionment."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'B. Inhabitants. Each district shall contain as nearly as possible the same number of inhabitants as determined according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, but districts shall not differ in number of inhabitants by more than 5% of the inhabitants in the smallest district created.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the variance 5% of the inhabitants in establishing legislative districts.
