HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" TO H.P. 68,
L.D. 98, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Accessible Polling Places
for the Physically Handicapped and the Elderly."

Amend the Amendment by inserting after the first paragraph
the following:

'Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §604, sub-§2, first paragraph, 3rd
sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 165, §2, is repealed.'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the beginning
of the first line of the 2nd paragraph the underlined
abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 2.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment deletes from present law the requirement
that an elderly or physically handicapped voter who wishes
to vote at the office of the clerk or at an alternative voting
place must notify the clerk of the municipality at least 10
days prior to the date of any election.
