SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P.  
83, L.D. 103, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning Open Alcoholic Beverage  
Containers in Motor Vehicles."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last underlined  
sentence of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in its place the  
following:

'Liquor bottles or other receptacles shall not be considered  
as open if the cover has been replaced securely. Replaced  
securely means covered so that the liquor bottle or other  
receptacle is leakproof.'
