COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 85, L.D. 105, Bill, "RESOLUTION, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Reducing the Size of the House of Representatives to 132 Members and Establishing the Size of the Senate at 33 Members."

Amend the Resolution in the 5th indented paragraph after the enacting clause in the 8th line by striking out the following underlined word "three" and inserting in its place the following underlined word 'four'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to correct an error in this resolution. If there are to be 33 Senators and 132 Representatives, and if each Senate district is to be comprised of the same number of House districts, then each Senate district must be comprised of 4 House districts, not 3 ( $4 \times 33 = 132$ ).
