AN ACT Relating to Expiration Date of Dance Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

8 MRSA § 161, 4th ¶, 2nd sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1967, c. 265, is amended to read:

All dancing licenses issued shall expire ~~December 31st of each year~~ **one year from date of issue** unless sooner revoked.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to effect a staggered licensing procedure for dance facilities and bring about a more efficient and economical enforcement process.
