HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 52, L.D. 109, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Duties of the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services Relating to Bilingual Education."

Amend the Bill in subsection 16 in the 2nd paragraph by adding at the end of the first underlined sentence the following: 'Bilingual instructors shall be subject to section 59, requiring certification of teachers by the State Board of Education in both course content and language of instruction.'

The purpose of this amendment is to require bilingual instruction to be subject to Title 20, section 59.
