
SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 52, L.D. 109, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Duties of the Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Services Relating to Bilingual Education."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end of that part designated subsection 16 the following underlined sentence:

'If an emergency situation should be created at the secondary level, the commissioner may give temporary approval for such programs.'
